The Community

The community of Downers Grove, Illinois, with a population of approximately 47,000, is in the southeastern portion of DuPage County and is located 19 miles west of Chicago.

The School District

Community High School District 99 serves the community of Downers Grove, and parts of Bolingbrook, Darien, Lisle, Oak Brook, Westmont and Woodridge. The mission of District 99, in cooperation with parents and the community, is to provide a caring and challenging environment where all students develop as lifelong learners to become contributing, responsible members of a changing world.

The Music Curriculum

The music curriculum in Community High School District 99 has a long tradition of excellence. District 99 has been recognized as the “Illinois Outstanding Total Music Program” by the *Illinois Music Educators Association* (one of only two school districts in the state to ever be recognized with this award). In 1999, the *National Academy of the Recording Arts and Sciences* named both Downers Grove North and South High Schools as “Grammy Signature Schools,” recognizing the music faculty and students as two of the top 150 programs in the United States.
